

## Case Study Four

### **Bailiwick Social Prescribing: making an impact on lives in the community**

A client was referred to us who was keen to go back to work but unsure how to access support to do this safely without any risk to their benefits. We arranged a meeting with the Job Centre and with our support the client attended this meeting and was able to discuss their concerns and worries and also their wishes for how to return to the job sector.

The Job Centre lead was really helpful in explaining the process to the client so they felt comfortable, and they were also aware they would still have Bailiwick Social Prescribing support through the process of finding jobs. We offered support to the client with writing their CV and applications and also referred them to the Guernsey Employment Trust Job club where they can also see available jobs and speak to the team there who can help with printing forms and suggesting suitable jobs.

This intervention had a great outcome for the client who is now happy in a new job, which makes them feel more worthwhile and less isolated.
